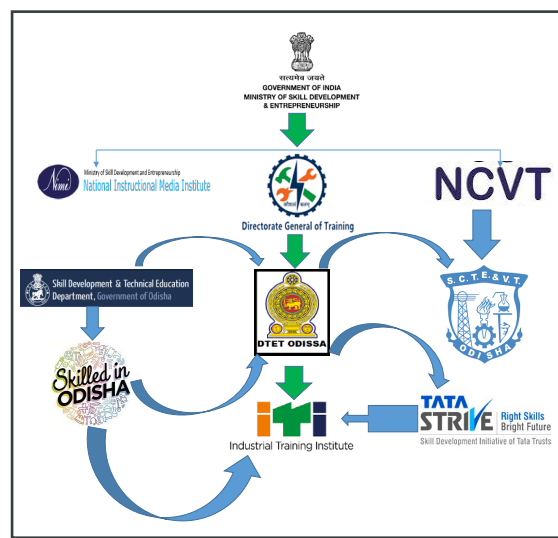
BRIDGE CLASS SESSIONS THROUGH VIRTUAL MODE

INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

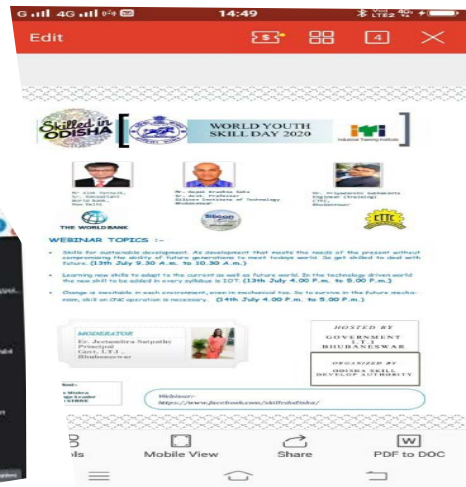

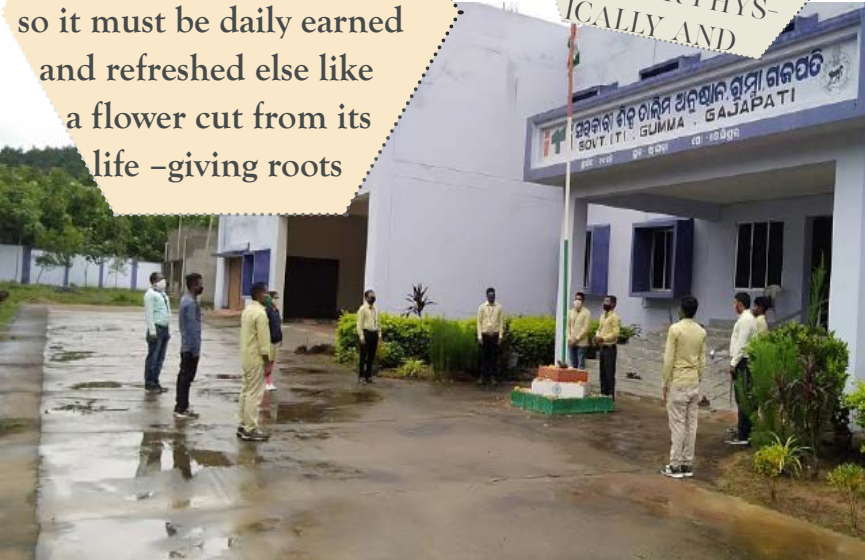


INDEPENDENCE DAY

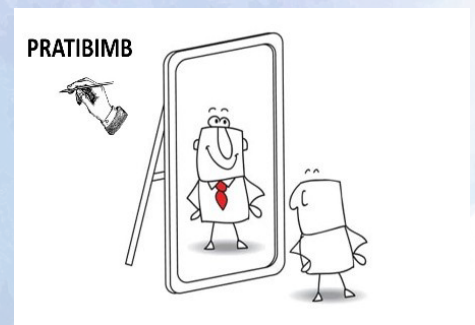

Aspirants for NEET Exam

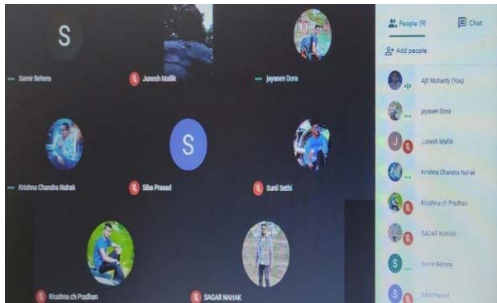

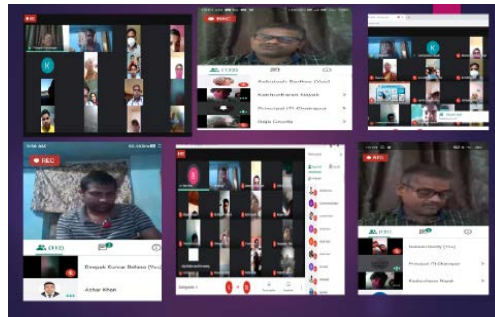


PLACEMENT

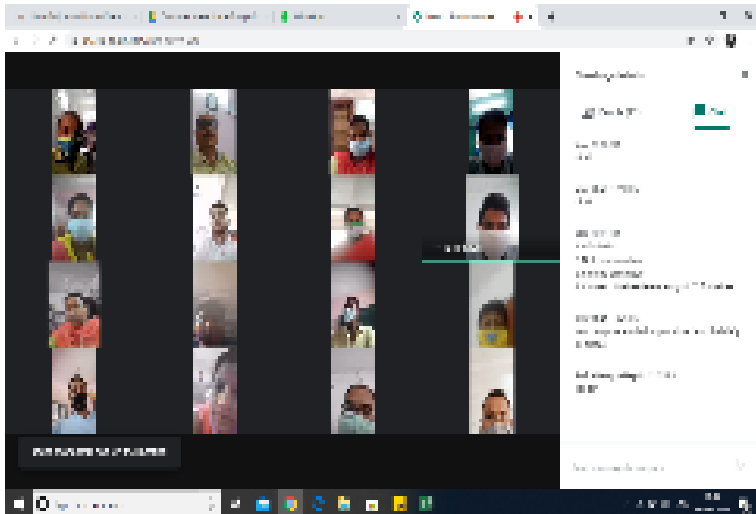
GOVT.ITI BOUDH

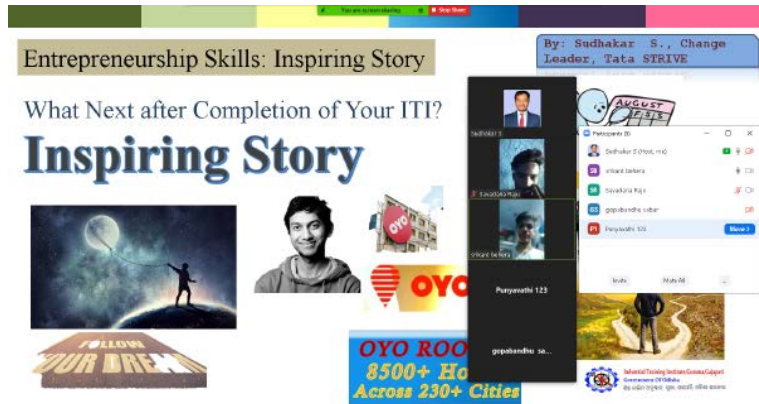

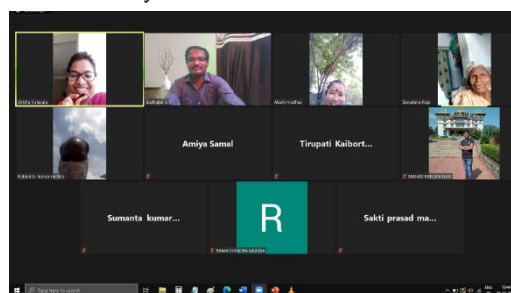
Special Plantation Drive

Responsibility of Teacher and Student

In an ITI a teacher has three levels of responsibility towards his or her students in relation to giving advice.

The first is the fulfilment of the prerequisite of getting to know his her students individually, to probe the innermost depths of their hearts as well as examining the outer details of their lives. As the teacher's familiarity grows, so the potency of his advice deepens proportionately.

Secondly, the teacher must express love and affection towards his students. It is this affection that dissolves the students' natural tendency to resist being told what to do. Thus the advice can penetrate more deeply and effectively.

Finally, teacher must take time to reflect upon the students' progress, refining and adjusting his vision how best to influence them towards positive change.

Students also have three elements which they must follow religiously. In relation to a holistic advisor, however the student needs to feel deference and admiration, for this creates willingness, and a desire to receive the teacher's instructions even though these instructions may be uncomfortable and disconcerting at times.

Secondly, The student must believe that a teacher always has his or her best interest in mind. If the student would sense some ulterior motive, some self-interest, or even carelessness in the teacher's instruction, he or she would not be able to surrender wholeheartedly to the teacher's advice, making the entire exchange meaningless.

Finally, the students must commit themselves to following the instructions with utmost discipline, for only then the intended effects be realized. Just as a doctor's orders must be followed precisely, failure to do so may result in more harm than good, so a teacher's "prescription" must be obeyed with equal conscientiousness and deference due to his superior knowledge and authority. What I view is student always feel glad and accept to be at their institutions.

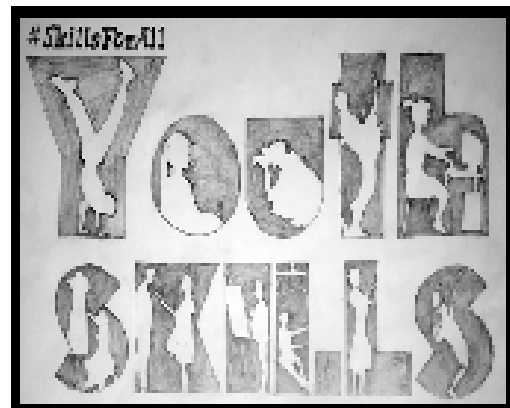
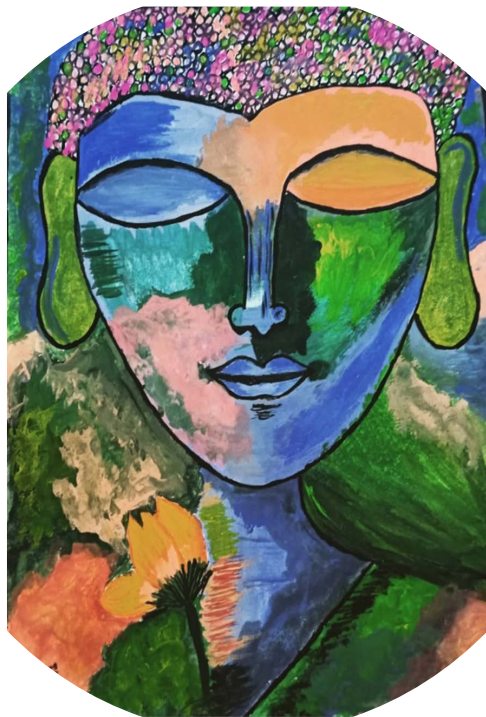
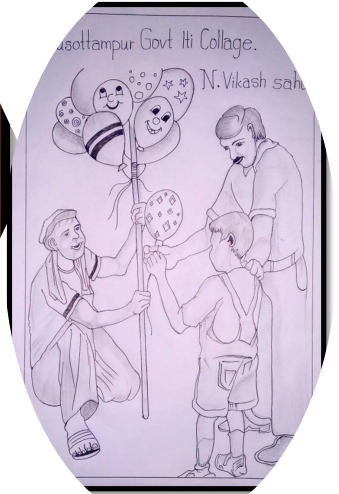
